DTM Open House

OMAHA, NEBRASKA – Distefano Technology & Manufacturing has a new home and is ready to show it off.

DTM has relocated to 3838 S. 108th St. (108th and I-80), the former Nashua Corp. building.

To celebrate the occasion, a grand opening will be held Wednesday, Aug. 31. The first of two tours of the new facility will start at 11 a.m., followed by a lunch from 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Sen. Ben Nelson will headline the presentations at 12:30 p.m., with a second tour at 1 p.m.

Distefano has been operating in two locations the last decade, so the new building offers more than 160,000 square feet in one site. The expanded location gives DTM the opportunity to grow with its customer base and to add machines and processes as the business continues to grow. DTM has 90 employees and hopes to expand to 100.

DTM fabricates more than 1,000 different metal components for various industries, including commercial turf care, agricultural, construction, transportation, medical and telecommunications.

Behlen Mfg. Co., which acquired DTM in 2008 from Bob and Tom Distefano, purchased the new building in March for DTM. Tom has since retired, but Bob remains on staff doing estimations and developing advanced software tools.

DTM is led by General Manager Brian Turner and Co-CEOs of Distefano are Behlen President and CEO Phil Raimondo and Behlen Vice Chairman of the Board Tony Raimondo Jr.
